Growing up in a difficult and challenging home environment, Sabrina feels fortunate to have had mentors in her life that unknowingly made

invaluable investments in her character and her future. Sabrina entered her first pageant at the age of 13, and never looked back! She truly believes that her experiences in pageants have played a crucial role in many of the successes in her life. She captured the *Mrs. Universe Ltd. 2014* title in Kuala Lumpur Malaysia, becoming the first woman from the United Sates to do so. Having a diverse background both professionally and personally Sabrina feels she can identify with the tough situations in life that we all experience. She was raised in a home plagued by violence at the hands of an alcoholic father, left her family home at 14, lived with a wonderful foster family. She went on to have a successful career in modeling, pageants, and dance.

At the age of 32 Sabrina was suddenly widowed after a tragic accident that took her husband's life. "Pain is inevitable suffering optional", through her pain she found strength in sharing her story to encourage others. After winning **Mrs. Universe Ltd. 2014** Sabrina was compelled to create **The Pledge Campaign – Against Domestic Violence.** "**The Pledge**" is a campaign geared toward giving men of all age's value in the fight against domestic abuse. "Survivors need to know there are good men out there and be reminded that not all men have the propensity to violence". "**The Pledge**" now includes **Her Pledge** – women pledging to take responsibility for which they allow to love them. **Kids Pledge** – which utilizes activities and stories that focus on kids understanding the power of words. Founding The **Transcontinental Pageant** TM system will assist in raising funds that will allow for the "**Beauty That Inspires Initiative**" (**R** to be presented to women and girls around the world via our title holders, who become spokeswomen for "**The Pledge**".

Sabrina feels fortunate to invest, hands on in the lives of at-risk kids that others have given up on or that might want to give upon them-selves. Mentoring and giving value to others is critical to the success of others.


I hope that you enjoy your time here and take time to become acquainted with the City of McDonough and Henry County.



I partnered with an international non-profit to help raise money to sponsor young girls in South Africa so they can further their high school education. This along with volunteering at hospices throughout our community, donating food, clothing, and blankets to our underserved, or hand sewing over one hundred masks for our healthcare providers, I learned what it was to truly come from a place of giving. This is what the title of Mrs. USA Universe has meant to me.

Thank you to my husband Jason for always being my greatest supporter and helping me to believe in myself. To Sabrina Pinion, you are the epitome of a true Queen from the inside out. It has been my privilege to represent the Transcontinental Pageants. Thank you for


