

Growing up in a difficult and challenging home environment, Sabrina feels fortunate to have had mentors in her life that unknowingly made invaluable

investments in her character and her future.

Sabrina entered her first pageant at the age of 13, and never looked back! She truly believes that her experiences in pageants have played a crucial role in many of the successes in her life. She captured the *Mrs. Universe 2014 Ltd.* title in Kuala Lumpur Malaysia, becoming the first woman from the United States to do so.

Having a diverse background both professionally and personally, Sabrina feels she can identify with the tough situations in life that we all experience. She was raised in a home plagued by violence at the hands of an alcoholic father, left her family home at 14 and lived with a wonderful foster family. She went on to have a successful career in modeling, pageants and dance.

At the age of 32, Sabrina was suddenly widowed after a tragic accident that took her husband's life. She believes that "Pain is inevitable suffering optional" so through her pain, she found strength in sharing her story to encourage others. After becoming Mrs. Universe Ltd. 2014 Sabrina was compelled to create, The Pledge Campaign – Against Domestic Violence (which is a registered 501C3 organization). "The Pledge" is a campaign geared toward giving men of all age's value in the fight against domestic abuse. "Survivors need to know there are good men out there and be reminded that not all men have the propensity for violence". "The Pledge" – which encourages men to STAND UP and SPEAK OUT against domestic abuse also includes: "The Pet Pledge – Pledge to do no harm; to protect", "Her Pledge" – women pledging to take responsibility for which they allow to love them. "Kids Pledge" – which utilizes activities and stories that focus on kids understanding the power of words.

Founding the Transcontinental Pageants system will assist in raising funds for shelters in local communities. Each *TCP* title holder becomes an Ambassador for The Pledge Campaign and helps to share its message with their states and countries.

A youth development professional for "Celebrate Life International" and a mentor for "Teach One to Lead One" (character building leadership program for elementary children and teens) Sabrina feels fortunate to invest, hands on in the lives of atrisk kids that others have given up on. Giving at-risk children and teens value through mentoring is critical to their sense of well-being and success on their own terms!
